

- Fasten duvet covers and pillow cases to prevent small items from being rolled up inside them.

Loading the tumble drver

Foreign objects can melt, burn, or explode.

Do not overload the drum. Overloading can give a disappointing drying result and cause unnecessary wear and tear to the laundry. It can also cause more creasing.

If you are drying without a fragrance flacon, close the socket. Push the tab on the
