Ensure that any foreign objects (e.g. detergent dispensing balls, lighters, etc.) have been removed from

■ Sort the laundry according to the type of fibre and weave, size, garment care label symbol and the drying level required.

Untangle the laundry.

- Check seams and stitching to ensure that padding and linings are intact.
- Fasten duvet covers and pillow cases to prevent small items from being rolled up inside them.
- Fasten hooks and eves.
- Tie together textile belts and apron ties.
- Sew in or remove loosened underwiring from bras.

Unfold the laundry and load loosely into the drum.

Do not overload the drum. Overloading can cause unnecessary wear and tear of the laundry, give a disappointing drying result and cause more
