
Drying

- Remove foreign objects (e.g. detergent dispensing balls, loose bra hangers, lighters and all objects) from the laundry.
- Fasten duvet covers and pillow cases to prevent small items from being rolled up inside them.

Do not overload the drum. Overloading can give a disappointing drying result and cause unnecessary wear and tear to the laundry. It can also cause more creasing.

- Check that the drum is empty.

If you are drying without a fragrance flacon, close the socket. Push the tab on the cover to the bottom (see arrow).
