

## Washing environmentally and economically

Programmes that are more efficient with regard to energy and water consumption generally have a longer running time. By extending the programme running time, the wash temperature that is actually reached can be reduced while still providing the same wash results.

For example, the ECO 40-60 programme has a longer running time than Cottons 40°C or 60°C, but the ECO 40-60 programme is more efficient in terms of energy and water consumption.

- To get the most out of your machine. load the maximum dry load for the programme you are using.

Use the *Express 20* programme for small, lightly soiled loads.
