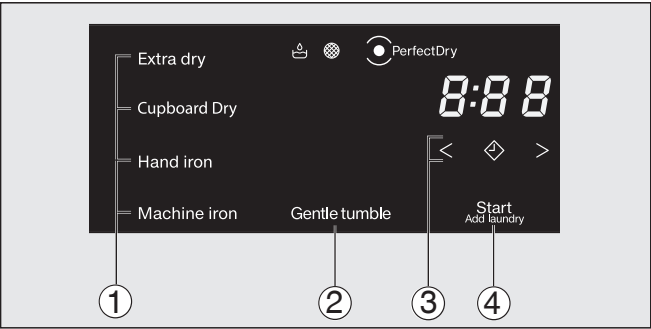




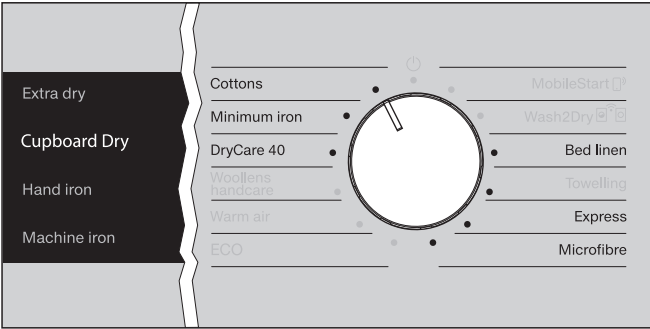

How the control field works



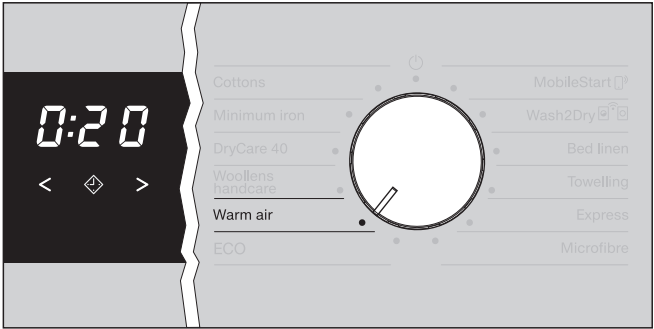
The ①-④ sensor controls react to fingertip contact. If a sensor control is illuminated, it can be selected.  
◊ sensor control = delay start period (then use < > to select the duration).

Select the drying level



- Touch the sensor control for the drying level.
- If a sensor control is brightly lit, this means it is currently selected
- If a sensor control is dimly lit, this means it can be selected

Select the time



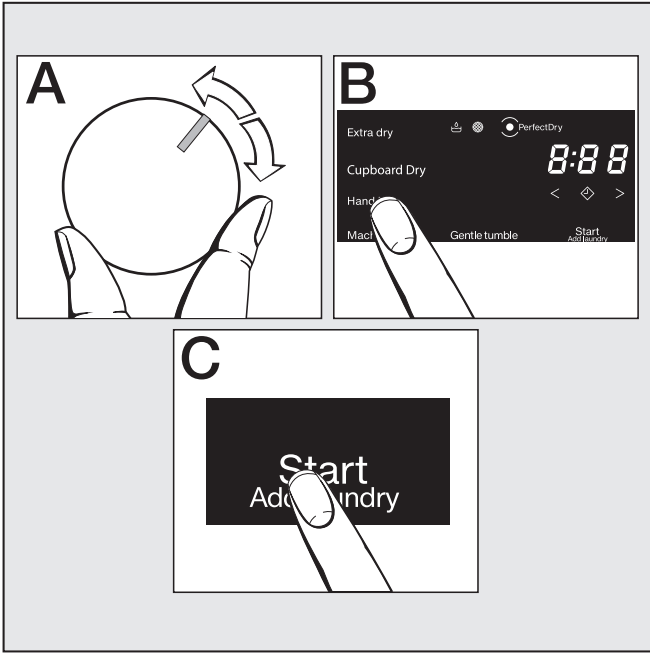
- Touch the < or > sensor control until the required duration lights up.
- You can select a duration of between 0:20 minutes and 2:00 hours.

① Sort the laundry and load the drum



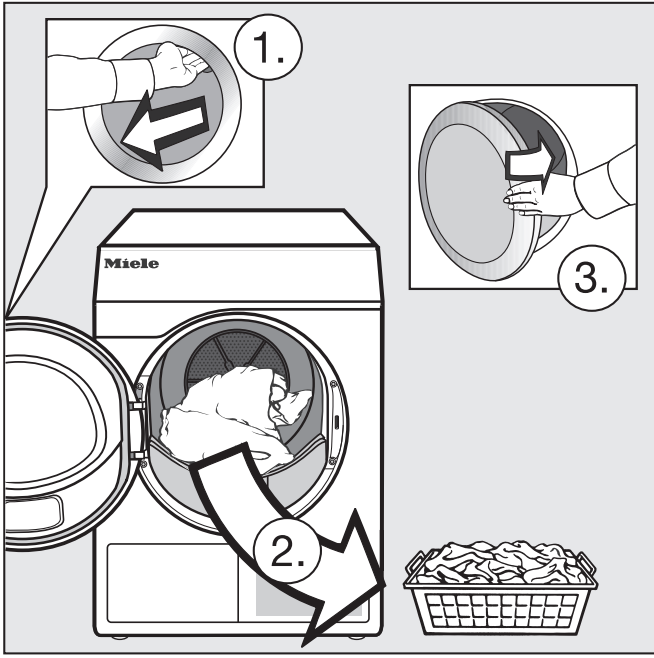
- ☒ = do not tumble dry
- ⦿ = normal/higher temperature
- ◻ = select *Gentle tumble* or *DryCare 40*
- Load the laundry

② Select and start the programme



- Select the programme
- Select the drying level or duration
- Touch the *Start/Add laundry* sensor

③ Unload the laundry



- End of programme: 0:00 is displayed
- Open the door
  - Unload the laundry

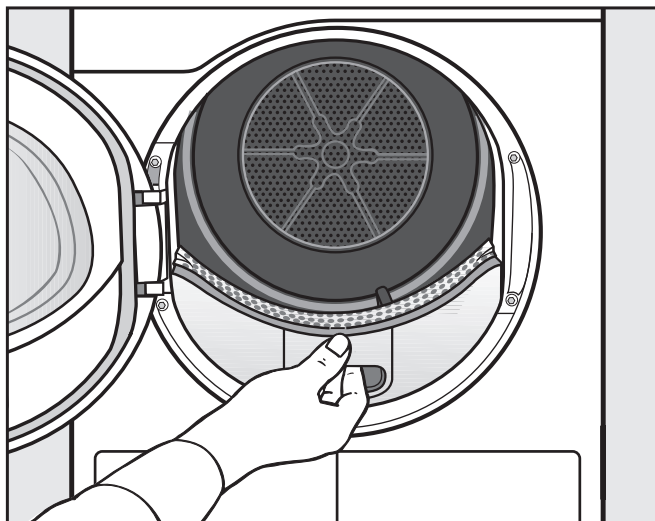

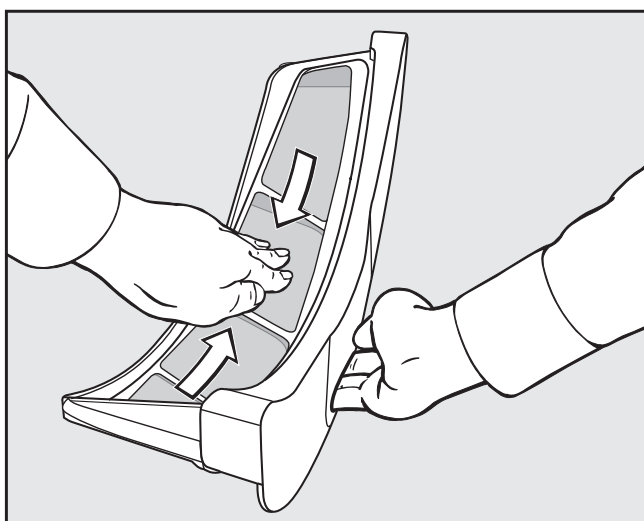

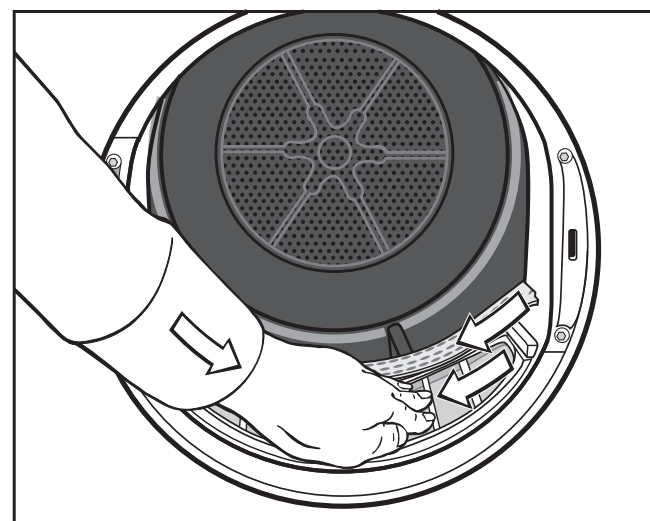
Tip: Have a vacuum cleaner ready



- Remove the fluff filter

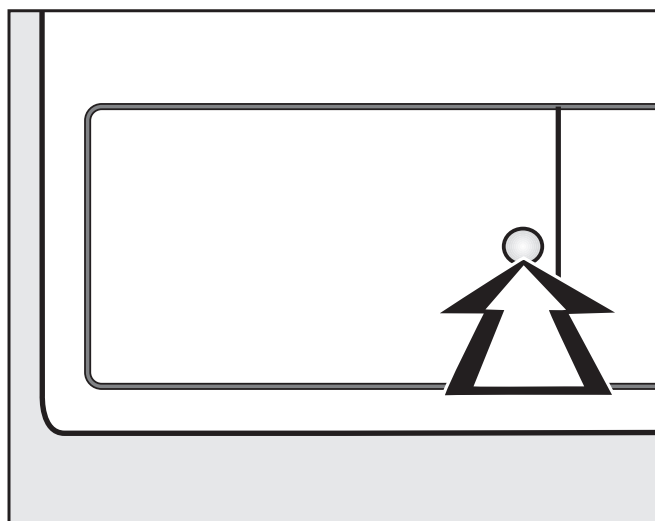


- Remove the fluff with your fingers or with a vacuum cleaner
- For heavy soiling: see the operating instructions

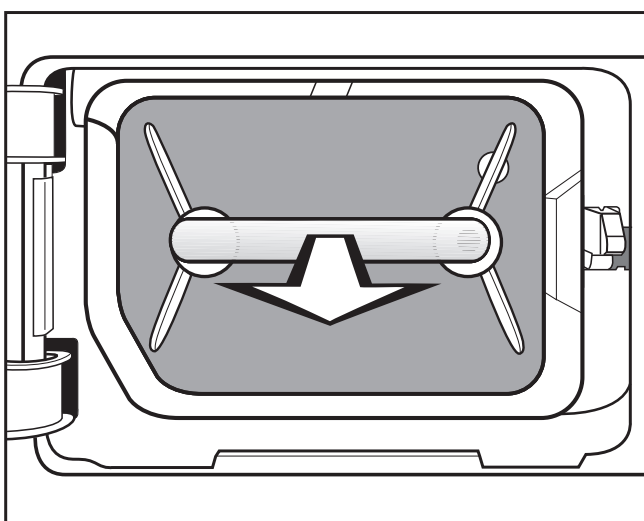


- Remove the fluff with your fingers or with a vacuum cleaner
- For heavy soiling: see the operating instructions

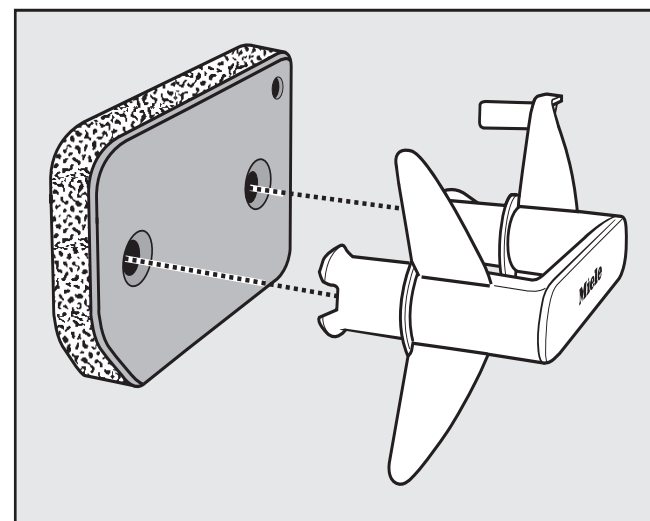
Clean once a day when in continuous use and when the  indicator light comes on\*



- Open the access panel



- Pull the plinth filter out by the handle



- Pull the handle out of the plinth filter
- Rinse the plinth filter, squeeze it gently and leave it to dry
  - Check the plinth filter at regular intervals for signs of wear
- Connect the handle
- Reinsert the plinth filter

\* **Switch off the  indicator light:**

- Open and close the door while the tumble dryer is switched on.
